in economics, the value of anything can be expressed in units of currency, or at least some sort of wealth: the amount of labour, materials, time, skills, or an abstract combination of such factors that can be converted into these units. the value of a good or service cannot be expressed in the same way, and so the value of a good or service is also commonly represented by some unit of quantity, for example, how much you want to pay for it. such representation is known as a representation of the value of a commodity is the amount of money in the form of coins or paper currency required to buy or purchase the good. (..) if a price does not include a share of the profits made by the seller it is known as a cost-based price. if the supplier of a service or product makes money out of supplying it to other people, he is commonly known as a supplier. if the supplier and the consumers of the product are the same person, as is the case with labour, then he is known as an employer. if, however, the main purpose of producing the product to consumers, then the producer is known as a manufacturer. in international trade, the term barter is used in many specialized exchanges involving commodities that are not currently for sale in the world markets, and which therefore require barter for value. these commodities are not generally tradeable on world exchanges for profit; rather, barter works because both parties are aware of a certain amount of value but no immediate market exists for this value. barter can also refer to the practice of using barter as a supplement to real currency, that is, alongside financial currency (usually bank notes or coins) (e.g., the u.s.a. dollar or euro) in the payment of goods or services. this practice is known as cashless barter.

performance testing is an assessment of the individual programmer's ability to implement the feature in question, as it is released into production. the way in which each of the programmer's implementations of a feature is developed will affect how well the feature is implemented (aure and sisodiya 2011). performance testing involves verifying if the programmers' code performs as well as expected. it is done by comparing the actual behavior of the software to the results that have been outlined in the requirements document. it might involve comparing the running time of a program, or an iteration time, or other measures of the effectiveness of the code (mitek 2011). performance testing is usually performed by a tester who is aware of the nature of the application and the task to be performed, and who can write well-factored and well-structured code. the tester must identify what it is that he or she wants to know about the software, the scope of the test, and the test environment. the tester can then come up with suitable strategies and apply them to test the application (aure and sisodiya 2011). similar to other security disciplines, software security engineering is concerned with the security of software itself. the goal of software security engineering is to create secure code at the outset, but this may be an impossible task and it may even be too late to make the code secure once it is in the wild. throughout the development process, the security needs of the software product are continuously checked (fenton and steuber 2017). as we stated above, they are the basic terms used to describe the stage of the software development process at which a specific instance of software has been created and produced for use in some given project (valenzuela et al. 2019). they are typically used to describe different parts of a software project, such as the development process, stages within the development process, and specific aspects of the development process. this chapter will explain what standards exist that cover different types of testing in the software development process, we will discuss the different types of testers that contribute to the process as well as the different roles they can occupy. we will explain and demonstrate the goal, task, and purpose of each tester type. then we will explain how these roles can be carried out and what the relationships between different testers and roles are, and finally we will discuss how these roles can be performed in order to achieve the goal, task, and purpose of the different testers within the roles. 5ec8ef588b
